SVMS Students Selected to Participate in the National Assessment of Educational Progress

Star Valley Middle School has been selected to represent schools across our state by contributing to the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP). NAEP is given by the U.S. Department of Education and tells us what students nationwide know and can do in key subject areas. It is the only ongoing nationally representative assessment that provides this information.

The NAEP assessment will be given in our school on Tuesday, February 5th 2019. If your child has been selected to take a reading or mathematics assessment you will receive a letter from the school with additional information. In addition to subject area questions, NAEP also asks students about their daily routine and their educational experiences. All student responses and results are anonymous and confidential.
