Creating an Infinite Campus Parent Account

(step-by-step instructions can be found on http://svms.lcsd2.org/ under Quick Links)

- Call SVMS at 885-5208 to obtain your activation key. If you have the activation key, proceed to step 2.
- 2. Navigate to http://lcsd2.infinitecampus.org/campus/portal/lincoln2.jsp and select the link that says "click here".
- Insert your activation key.
- 4. Create a username and password.
- Click the link to navigate back to the login page and login with the new credentials you created.
- Don't forget to check out the Infinite Campus Mobile Portal App to track your child's grades, attendance, assignments and lunch balance. Online lunch payments may only be made on your Internet Parent Account.
