



STUDENT DRESS CODE HIGHLIGHTS FOR OSMOND ELEMENTARY, ETNA ELEMENTARY & SVMS

Our dress code helps maintain a safe, respectful and focused learning environment.



Appropriate dress helps students focus on learning, keeps everyone safe, and shows respect for our school community.

ACCEPTABLE
items may include:



PANTS must be worn at the waist. Holes in pants must be below fingertips when arms are relaxed at the side.



TOPS must fully cover the torso and provide shoulder coverage.



SHORTS, SKIRTS & DRESSES must come below fingertips when arms are relaxed at the side and provide adequate coverage during standing, sitting and movement.



NOT
ACCEPTABLE
items may include:

No holes that extend above the fingertips unless leggings are worn underneath.



No shorts or skirts that are too short unless paired with leggings or compression shorts that come below fingertips.

No sleeveless shirts or tank tops



No bare midriffs, no low-cut tops (front and/or back), no lace/see through shirts

Hats, bandanas, sweatbands, and sunglasses may not be worn indoors unless for approved purposes (e.g. religious or medical). Footwear with wheels, noisemakers, or damaging features is not allowed. Appropriate athletic shoes are required during PE.



Skateboards and scooters are not allowed.
