



STAR VALLEY MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE



APPROPRIATE

Appropriate dress helps students focus on learning, keeps everyone safe, and shows respect for our school community.

PANTS

- Must be worn at the waist.
- Holes in pants must be below the fingertips when arms are relaxed at the side.



TOPS

- Must fully cover the torso.
- Provide adequate shoulder coverage.



SHORTS, SKIRTS, & DRESSES

- Must be below the fingertips when arms are relaxed at the side.
- Provide adequate coverage when standing, sitting & moving.



HATS, BANDANAS, SWEATBANDS, & SUNGLASSES may not be worn indoors unless for approved purposes (e.g., religious or medical).



NOT APPROPRIATE

Clothing that is distracting, unsafe or disrespectful is not allowed.



Thin straps, spaghetti straps, or oversized armholes



Bare midriffs, low-cut tops, or exposed back/sides



Pajamas, blankets, or slippers



Holes, rips or tears above the fingertips



Shorts, skirts or dresses that are too short



EXPLICIT OR INAPPROPRIATE CLOTHING

Clothing, accessories, or items that:

- Display alcohol, tobacco, drug, or drug related slogans
- Contains inappropriate or lewd messages
- Are see-through or reveal undergarments
- Are excessively tight, loose, or revealing.

ADDITIONAL REMINDERS



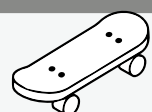
FOOTWEAR

Shoes must be worn at all times for safety. Fashion, sneakers, or damaging features is not allowed. — appropriate athletic shoes are required for PE & activities.



JEWELRY & ACCESSORIES

Jewelry must be safe and non-disruptive. Items such as heavy chains, spike jewelry, chokers, or wallet chains are not permitted.



PROHIBITED ITEMS

Items such as skateboards, scooters, roller skates, and rollerblades are not allowed during the school day. Anything that disrupts the educational environment or compromises safety will be addressed at the discretion of school administration.



BAGS & OUTERWEAR

Heavy coats, backpacks, and large bags should be stored in designated areas (lockers, hooks, or cubbies). Light jackets, sweaters, and sweatshirts may be worn in class. Full-length coats (e.g., trench coats/dusters) are not permitted.



HAIR & APPEARANCE

Students may wear hairstyles and hair colors of their choice. Hair must be maintained in a manner that does not create a health or safety hazard and does not substantially disrupt the educational environment.



COSTUMES & SPECIAL ATTIRE

Costumes, pajamas, and costume-like accessories (e.g., capes, masks, tails, flags worn as capes) are not permitted except on designated school-approved spirit or dress-up days.
